<i>Behavioural Offence</i>	<i>Consequence(s)</i>
Swearing – Inappropriate Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st Offence - reminder with apology • 2nd Offence – lose a recess • 3rd Offence – see administrator
Verbal Aggression/ Disrespect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st Offence - lose a recess with apology • 2nd Offence – lose 3 recesses with apology • 3rd Offence – see administrator and possible suspension
Vandalism	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st Offence - lose 1-3 recesses with apology and manual job • 2nd Offence – lose 4-5 recesses with apology, manual job • 3rd Offence – see administrator and possible suspension
Lying	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st Offence - lose a recess with apology • 2nd Offence – lose 3 recesses with apology • 3rd Offence – see administrator
Stealing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st Offence – see administrator, lose 1-3 recesses with apology and restitution • 2nd Offence – see administrator, 1 day in school suspension with apology, restitution • 3rd Offence – see administrator, 3 days home suspension with apology, restitution
Physical Aggression (push, trip, etc.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st Offence - lose a recess with apology • 2nd Offence – lose 3 recesses with apology • 3rd Offence – see administrator
Disruptive Behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st Offence - lose a recess with apology • 2nd Offence – lose 3 recesses with apology • 3rd Offence – see administrator
Fighting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st Offence – see administrator, parents contacted , apology, lose 1-5 recesses • 2nd Offence – see administrator, 1 day in school suspension with apology • 3rd Offence – see administrator, 3 days home suspension with apology

PLEASE NOTE: All offences will include parental or guardian contact. Those students with existing behavioural plans will have different repercussions. These are guidelines only and may change depending on the severity of the offence. Further offences may lead to board attention for further discussions and decisions.
